Recreational Fire Pit Above and Below Ground

- 1. Fire pit can be no more than three (3) feet across.
- 2. If below grade pit must be no less that one (1) foot deep.
- 3. If above grade must be ringed with a non-combustible material at least one (1) foot in height such as metal, brick, rock (round river rock will explode when heated).
- 4. Must have border of non-combustible material at a minimum of fifteen (15) feet across such as brick, gravel, damp green grass.
- 5. Must be a minimum of fifteen (15) feet from all combustible material such as landscaping, fences, decks, structures.
- 6. During use there must be a water source (garden hose) nearby.
- 7. Only dry cord type firewood may be burned.
- 8. Fire must be attended by an adult (18yrs of age) at all times.
- 9. Fire must be completely extinguished after each use.
- 10. Recreational fire may be prohibited due to hazardous conditions.

Commercially Manufactured Fire Pit

- 1. Fire pit can be no more than four (4) feet across.
- 2. Must have border of non-combustible material at a minimum of fifteen (15) feet across such as brick, gravel, damp green grass.
- 3. Must be a minimum of fifteen (15) feet from all combustible material such as landscaping, fences, decks, structures.
- 4. During use there must be a water source (garden hose) nearby.
- 5. Only dry cord type firewood may be burned.
- 6. Fire must be attended by an adult (18yrs of age) at all times.
- 7. Fire must be completely extinguished after each use.
- 8. Recreational fire may be prohibited due to hazardous conditions.
